May 11-13 at Corachree, Tarland

Hi everyone

Oh yes – its back for it's third year..THE camp of the year!! First class dressage, SJ and XC tuition on hill in beautiful countryside in Aberdeenshire with glorious hacking and a barrelload of fun (oh and drinks if the last few years are anything to go by!) You don't have to camp - try The Commercial (£40 per person BB- 013398 81922) in the village a mile away.

The changes for 2012 are:

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- £5 price increase plus £2 extra per night for stables (due to increased price of straw) BUT:
- Camp opens at the earlier time of 12noon Friday to let you settle, get pen and tent up and hack.
- Games are teatime Friday instead of Sunday
- Stovies Fri night are included as well as BBQ Sat
- There is a brand new mains electric circuit – very strong!! This will be on ALL THE TIME for the mini pens so you must bring fence tape, posts AND a plastic handle for your pen to stop you getting shocked every time you try and open it!!
- A muck cart will be by the mini paddocks for ease – we are working on a water bowser!!

There are strictly only 7 stables available. Priority is given to laminitics. As per last year, the majority of horses are kept in individual mains electric fenced pens within a huge electric fenced area within a fully fenced and gated field!!!

Camp is £90 this year. Stabling is an extra £12 per night and includes straw only.

THE LESSONS

We aim to accommodate your preferences as much as possible but please allow for a little flexibility. The XC course at Corachree is excellent for first timers right through to intermediate – and there are a few good open fences too. There's water, trakehners, steps, corners, ditches, drops etc..all within one big training field. The SJ and flatwork areas are near the stables. If you'd just like to come up, hack, have some flatwork lessons or do some polework, then we will work that in for you. Likewise, XC galore if you love that.
