## RULES

- The judges decision is final.
- The practice jump is not to be put any higher than 3" above the height of the class that is ongoing
- Horse/ Rider combinations may only compete in a maximum of three classes and only one league class.
- If you wish to take part in more than one league class then you must do the smaller class HC.
- Horse/ rider combinations can move up a league at any time however all points will be forfeited and you will have to start the new league on zero points.
- Riders may compete in more than one league class.
- Horses/ Ponies may only compete in one league class and must have the same rider throughout the league.
- In the case of equality at the league final a further and final timed round will decide the winner.
- Wining combinations from this league must move to the league above next year. Members will remain in the league for summer show jumping until the AGM.
- League winners must be present at the league final, if the league winner is not present the league will be awarded to the combination with the next most points.

### Restrictions

**Mini Minimus:** Horse/ rider combination never to have been placed at minimus more than 3 times or competed at novice or above in an open competition.

**Minimus:** Horse/ rider combination never to have been placed at novice more than 3 times or competed at intermediate or above in an open competition.

**Novice:** Horse/ rider combination never to have been placed at intermediate more than 3 times or competed at small open or above in an open competition. Horses should have no more than £60 BSJA winnings.

**Intermediate:** Horse/ rider combination never to have been placed at open more than 3 times. Horses should have no more than £130 BSJA winnings.

**Small Open:** No Restrictions

**Height classes:** No Restrictions

The competition will be run under BSJA 2007 rules.

The judge's decision is final.
